What is Cluster Connect?

Cluster Connect is a short-term exchange activity between clusters and support organizations from similar or different industrial ecosystems. It involves twinning, matchmaking and knowledge sharing activities between a South Mediterranean cluster – the Visitor and a host organization – the Host.

Cluster Connect is implemented by Berytech for 2 years in the Euromed Region. Berytech is the partner of the EuroMed Clusters Forward (ECF) Project that is funded by EU-DG NEAR and coordinated by ANIMA Investment Network.

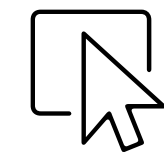

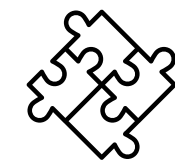

Role of Berytech

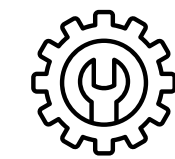

Batch 1 Timeline: _____



Call for interest for Clusters + Hosts

- **November 2023:** SouthMed Clusters apply as Visitor on the application form, while hosts express their interest in becoming hosts.
- **End of December 2023:** 5 Clusters are selected and will later have to share the 'Call for Hosts' once launched, contact, and invite the hosts to apply.



Call for Host

- **Beginning of January - End of January 2024:** A 'Call for Hosts' will be launched for hosts to apply their proposal and receive a cluster.
- **End of January - Mid February 2024:** Hosts are selected and contracted.



Mission

- **Mid February - End of May 2024:** Hosts will conduct needs assessment & develop the agenda of the mission. Implementation of virtual activities and face-to-face mission.



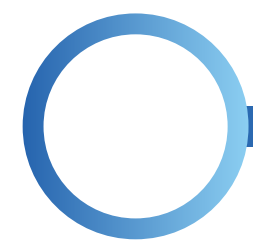
Batch 1 Wrap-Up

- **End of May 2024:** Clusters (Visitors) and Hosts report to Berytech.

Activity Timeline

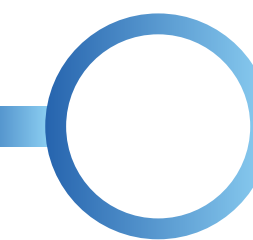

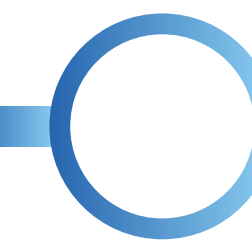

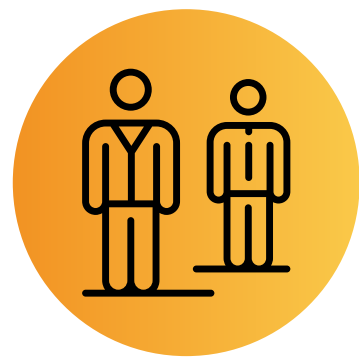
Host (one of the following)

Benefits of Cluster Connect



Visitor

- Exploring collaboration and growth opportunities.
- Acquiring specific labels or certificates.
- Securing trade deals and legal consultations and gaining knowledge of foreign markets.
- Strengthening the strategy and operational models and creating new business development opportunities.
- Gain sectoral knowledge and skills.
- Exposure and visibility for the cluster in foreign markets.



Host

- Exposure and visibility for the organization and services provided.
- Networking and developing cross-border collaborations.
- Gaining knowledge of new foreign markets.

The allocated budget for this activity including the expertise support mission, travel and accommodations expenses will be covered by Berytech.

Selection Criteria ---

- Visitors are based in the EuroMed eligible countries (Lebanon, Palestine, Jordan, Egypt, Algeria, Tunisia, Morocco).
- Visitors are registered on ECCP Platform.
- Visitors have a clear management team structure (existing or under development).
- Visitors have a clear mission and are currently implementing activities for their members.
- Visitors have clear objectives and expectations for the Cluster Connect Mission.
- Balance between the 7 eligible countries.
- Visitors secure a minimum of 3 proposals from 3 different Hosts with the assistance of Berytech.

--- Phases & Activities

Berytech will be developing the Cluster Connect activities based on a needs assessment phase followed by an action plan determined by the Host and the Visitor across two-months (virtual and face-to-face visit to the host country).

Selected clusters will immensely contribute to the recruitment of the Host by identifying potential hosts, sharing the call with their network of experts, and disseminating the calls across different channels. They may also review partnership profiles on the ECCP to identify potential hosts.

Phases

Cluster Connect is split into four phases:



Phase 1:

Needs assessment, action plan and agenda.



Phase 2:

Implementation of virtual activities according to the agenda.



Phase 3:

Travel mission (for up to 3 individuals representing the cluster).



Phase 4:

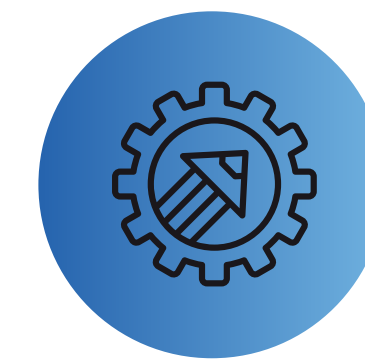

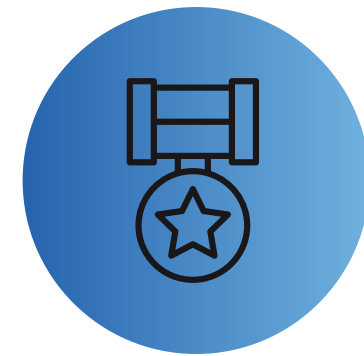

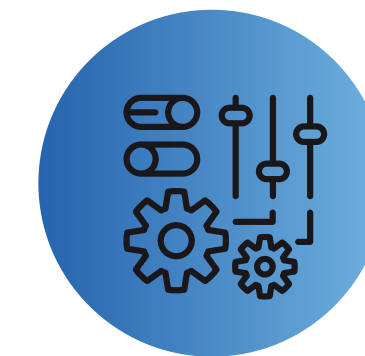
