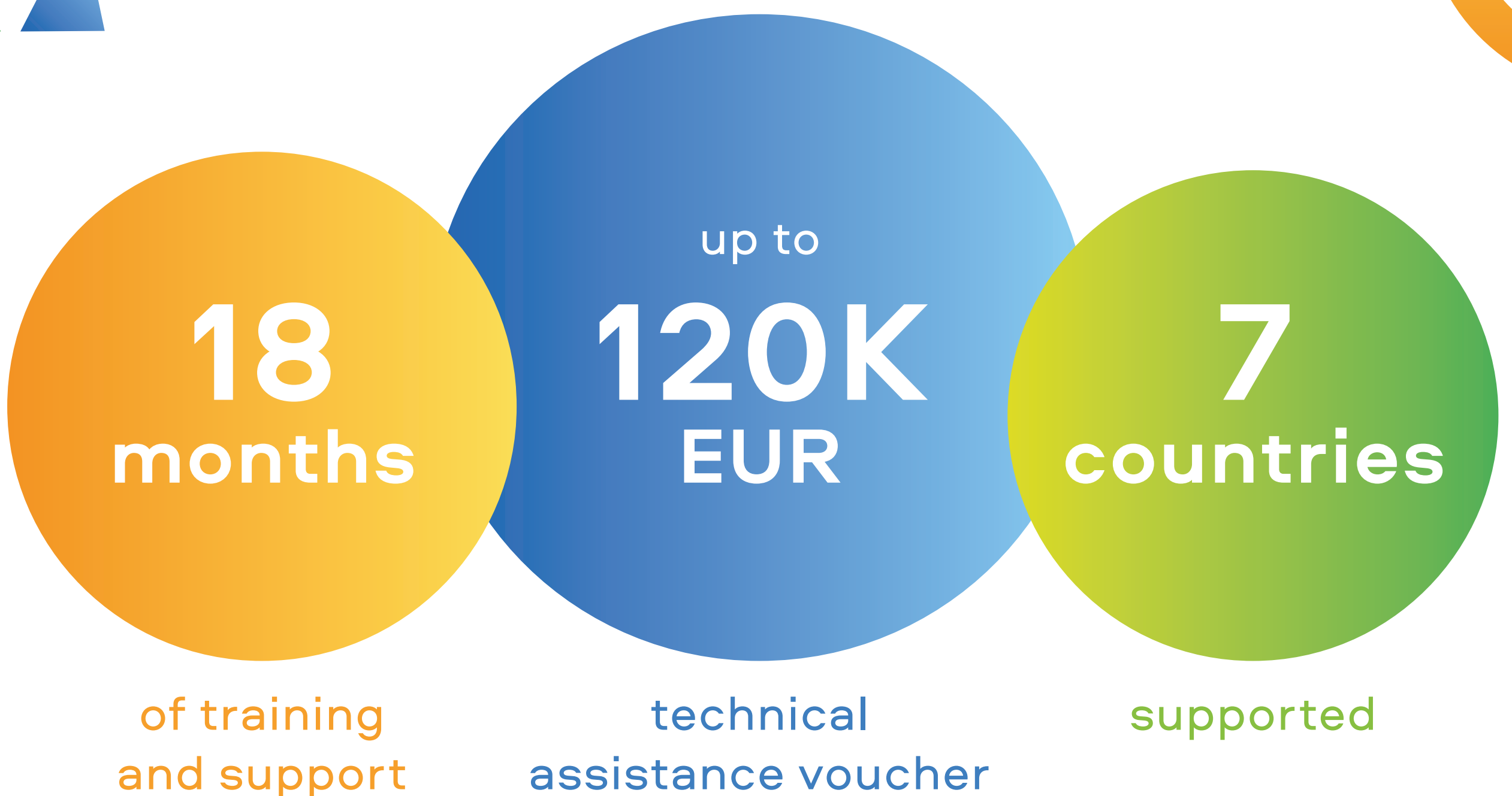


What is Cluster Booster?

Cluster Booster is a comprehensive technical assistance voucher under Euromed Clusters Forward.

Led by Berytech, it aims at enhancing the capabilities of clusters in the South Mediterranean region, by providing technical assistance and capacity building for cluster managers, staff, and SME members.

Key focuses include establishing and improving governance and sustainability models, developing strategies for better market positioning, and enhancing technological and innovation capabilities to foster North-South Mediterranean collaboration.

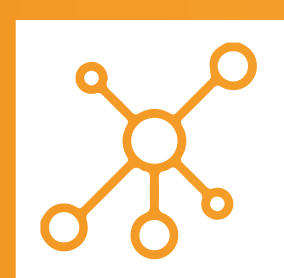

Who can Apply?

New clusters or initiatives, existing or advanced clusters, consortium – or groups of several clusters aiming to implement a common project:



New clusters exploring growth with a clear vision and needs for management resources.



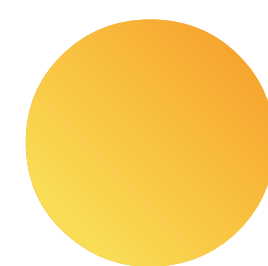
Existing clusters with a strong growth value proposition, and an existing track record, must be registered on ECCP.



- Geographic area: Candidates based in the Euromed Clusters Forward eligible countries*
- Focus sectors: Primary & Food Industries, Service Industries, Traditional Industries, ICT & Mid/High Tech Industries, or Creative Industries

Selected candidates for the Cluster Booster program will commit to pay 10% of the program budget in line with the cost-sharing program requirement.

*(Algeria, Egypt, Jordan, Lebanon, Palestine, Tunisia, or Morocco)



ANIMA Investment Network and Leaders International will be responsible for supporting candidates coming from:

- Lebanon: 2 candidates for EUR 60,000 each
- Egypt: 1 track candidate for EUR 120,000

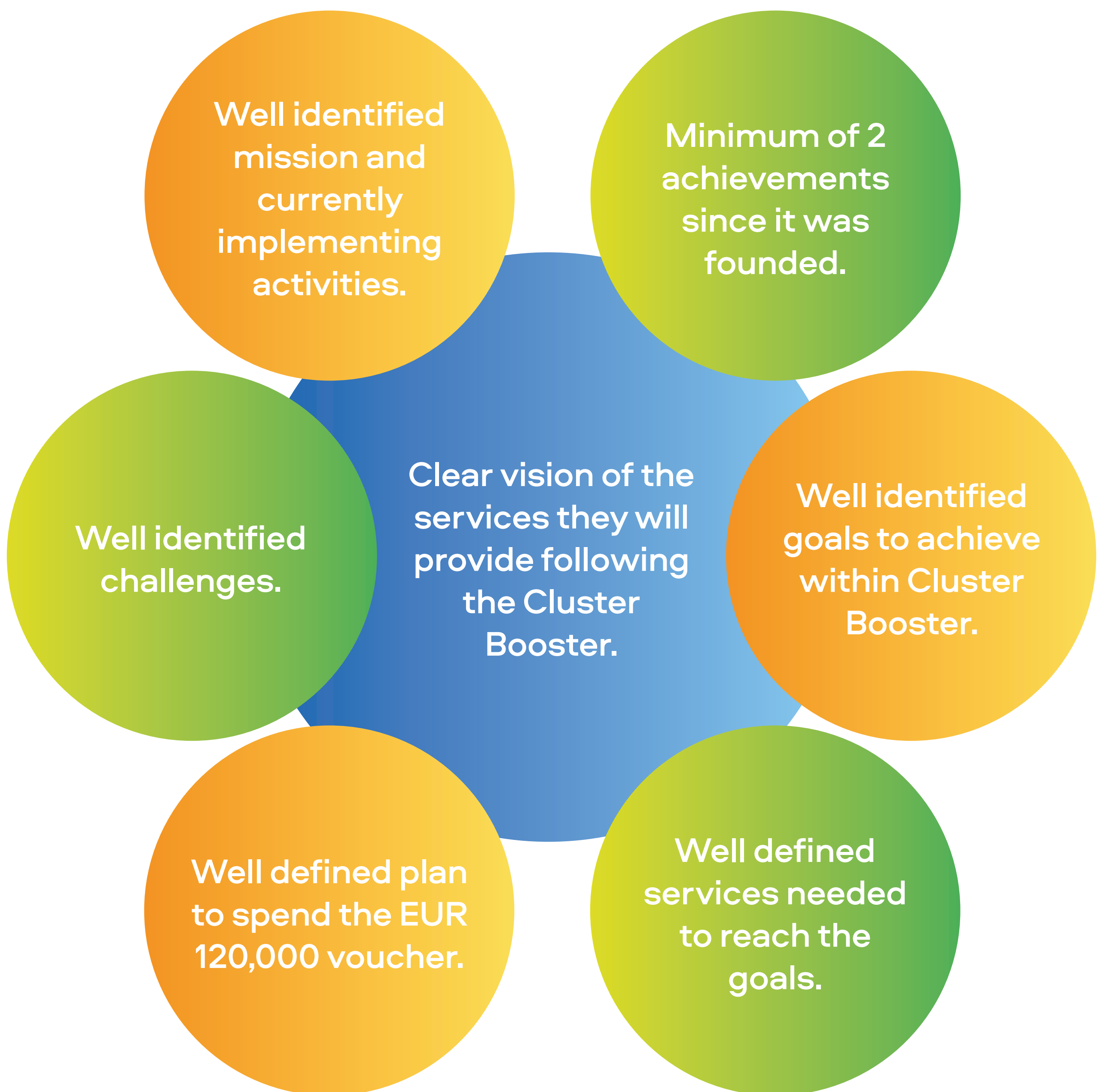
