The SMEs Programs division has been committed to fostering innovation and resilience among small and medium enterprises in Lebanon and the MENA region. Throughout 2024, our initiatives have continued to provide the necessary support and resources to enable these businesses to thrive and make a positive impact on their communities. By leveraging strategic partnerships and targeted funding, we continue to drive sustainable development and economic growth



## Achievements

1

**Launch of FSC Cycle 4:** In May 2024, Berytech, in collaboration with WFP, launched the 4th cycle of the FSC program to strengthen 11 new SMEs in the food sector, focusing on dairy, meat, cereals, pulses, horticulture, and edible plants. The program offers financial support, technical assistance, and capacity building to improve value chains, promote local sourcing, and reduce food waste. It also aims to enhance food security and sustainability through better processing, marketing, and climate adaptation measures.

**BASATINE at HORECA Lebanon:** At HORECA Lebanon 2024, the BASATINE program supported 40 SMEs in showcasing their products and expanding networks. Over 100 matchmaking sessions, organized by the QOOT cluster, connected SMEs with five prospective buyers to align offerings with market needs. The event also boosted SMEs' export potential and brand recognition among industry leaders.

**Building Investment Readiness Activity:** The Building Investment Readiness activity engaged 160 SMEs in 270 hours of workshops focused on investment preparedness, export readiness, R&D, product development, and process optimization. These workshops equipped SMEs with tools to improve efficiency, product quality, and market positioning. By fostering innovation and scalability, the initiative helped SMEs attract investment, expand into new markets, and drive long-term growth and sustainability.



**BASATINE**

BASATINE is a four-year consortium program aimed at supporting small farms' recovery and preserving employment for vulnerable populations. Funded by l'Agence Française de Développement (AFD), it is run by a consortium of six NGOs: CARE, Mercy Corps, Berytech Foundation, Georges N. Frem Foundation, Lebanese Organization for Studies and Training, and Al Majmoua.

**FOOD** SYSTEM  
CHALLENGE

The Food System Challenge helps businesses address key challenges in Lebanon's food system, focusing on dairy and meat production, cereals and pulses, protected horticulture, and domesticated edible plants. Implemented by the World Food Programme (WFP) and Berytech, the initiative receives support from the German Federal Ministry of Economic Cooperation and Development (BMZ).

### WE4F MENA

The Water and Energy for Food program, through its Regional Innovation Hubs, supports water-food, energy-food, and water-energy-food innovations with financial aid, technical assistance, and investment facilitation. These innovations help smallholder farmers access vital resources like inputs, finance, technology, and markets, thereby enhancing climate resilience and reducing CO2 emissions.

The year 2024 marked the peak of WE4F's impact and efforts, following years of dedicated groundwork. During this time, over 35 new companies were onboarded to begin their transformation journeys, while more than 20 alumni from previous cohorts continued receiving support through technical assistance and investment facilitation. Additionally, the WE4F MENA Hub formally launched efforts to design a regional impact fund, backed by leading global financial advisors. This year, the MENA Hub significantly surpassed most of its targets, especially in driving social and environmental impact and attracting substantial private sector investment. These accomplishments reinforced WE4F's position as a successful model for public-private partnerships, demonstrating its effectiveness in advancing sustainable innovation and economic growth.



## Achievements

1

**Selection and Onboarding of 20 Innovators:** WE4F MENA Hub selected and onboarded 20 innovators from across the region, including Iraq, which was part of a special track. These companies were invited to our annual regional convening in Cyprus, where they engaged with graduates from previous cohorts, exchanged lessons learned, and participated in interactive workshops.

**Hosting the WE4F Global Annual Convening:** The WE4F MENA Hub hosted the Global Annual Convening in Marrakesh, Morocco, bringing together donor representatives and over 100 innovators from around the world for a three-day event featuring unconference sessions, pitching opportunities, and networking activities.

**Support for Food Processors in Lebanon:** WE4F MENA launched and successfully closed a dedicated call to support 15 food processors in Lebanon. These companies, selected for their ability to rapidly scale production in a sustainable manner, received support as part of efforts to mitigate the impact of the war on the food value chain, particularly in the South and Beqaa regions.

2024 has been a transformative year for the Innovation Hub. We've not only expanded our reach across Lebanon but also taken significant strides in empowering both entrepreneurs and business support organizations. Our initiatives have fueled innovation, resilience, and sustainable growth, helping businesses scale and make a tangible impact in their communities. By leveraging strategic partnerships and targeted support, we continue to drive economic development across the MENA region



## Achievements

1

**Immersion and Softlanding Trips:** In 2024, five startups from Agrytech batch 6 participated in an immersion trip to Wageningen, Netherlands, with StartLife. Later, three Agrytech startups attended the F&A Next event as part of a soft-landing trip to the Netherlands. Additionally, startups from Clyntech batch 3 took part in an immersion trip to Delft, NL, with Yes!Delft.

**DAWERR Closing and Entrepreneur Development:** The DAWERR activity under Berytech concluded after three years of supporting over 100 entrepreneurs with innovative solutions for the waste sector. Launched in 2021, the program transformed businesses and improved the socio-economic well-being of Lebanese citizens through a solid waste recovery initiative in rural areas. In 2024, five startups graduated, receiving grants to pilot and scale their solutions, further advancing Recycling Value Chains (RVCs).

**REAF Program Success and EFQM Certification:** The REAF program wrapped up its first and second batches in 2024, graduating a new cohort of rural entrepreneurs in agri-food. Additionally, two key community stakeholders, Michel Daher Foundation (MDF) and Rural Entrepreneurs (RE), achieved the prestigious EFQM certification, marking a significant milestone in advancing innovation support.

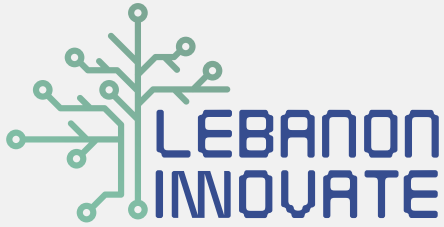
**ECF Regional Academy in Cairo:** The Regional Academy in Cairo, organized by Berytech in coordination with IceAlex, aimed to strengthen the financial strategies of Southmed clusters for long-term sustainability. It brought together eight clusters from the region for expert-led sessions by Sonia Fernandez from AMEC on financial models, funding access, and sustainability, along with visits to the British University of Egypt. The event fostered networking and collaboration, concluding with a policy dialogue to connect clusters with Egypt's public sector and pave the way for future partnerships.

**TESSA Green Transformation Academy:** Berytech launched the Green Transformation Academy to help 20 SMEs adopt circular economy principles and sustainable business strategies. The program provided a comprehensive curriculum on waste reduction, sustainable product design, and resource management, with hands-on learning through interactive sessions and case studies. Participants received tailored coaching and practical tools to develop and implement green strategies in their businesses.

**The Lebanon Innovate Academy in Cyprus,** held in June, gathered fourteen Lebanese participants from eight universities and research centers to explore partnership development and EU interregional cooperation. Organized by Invest Cyprus and ANIMA Investment Network, the academy offered networking, knowledge exchange, and access to EU funding, positioning Cyprus as a gateway for business expansion. As part of Lebanon Innovate's mission to connect academia and industry, the academy equipped innovators with tools for international scaling, with a follow-up planned for April 2025 in France.



Lebanon Innovate is a 42-month initiative funded by the European Union. It aims to revitalize the Lebanese entrepreneurial ecosystem by fostering innovation and supporting Intellectual Property (IP) development and knowledge transfer. The program equips startups and businesses with the tools to create a knowledge-driven, digital future, positioning Lebanon at the forefront of innovation.



The TESSA program promotes energy transition in Lebanon by raising awareness, providing training, and supporting businesses with green business plans. Berytech leads the implementation of this program, alongside other partners, helping companies integrate sustainable practices into their operations. TESSA is funded by Agenzia Italiana per la Cooperazione allo Sviluppo and co-funded by the Gouvernement Princier – Principauté de Monaco. The project is implemented by ICU in partnership with Enea, Elis Innovation Hub, Fondation Diane, and Berytech

**EUROMED  
CLUSTERS  
FORWARD**

Funded by the European Union, the Euromed Clusters Forward project aims to improve the regulatory framework of clusters in the Mediterranean, boost sustainable growth, and foster collaboration between EU and Southern Mediterranean clusters. Berytech plays a critical role in this initiative by mobilizing experts and supporting innovation clusters.

### Research and Innovation

European project "Sustaining AIQ Lebanon", a platform supporting over 150 students and teachers to collaborate in learning projects. Over 100 teachers have been trained on research and writing, and emerging technology into schools through workshops and coaching (2021 - 2024).

QOOT Cluster's 2024 journey was about impact, fueling agrifood innovation, sustainability, and export readiness, while fostering collaboration to strengthen Lebanon's position in global markets.



## Achievements

**QOOT Cluster Earns Silver Label Again:** QOOT Cluster earned the Silver Label for Cluster Management Excellence for the second time, ranking among 1,200 global clusters recognized by the European Secretariat for Cluster Analysis (ESCA). This achievement underscores its commitment to strengthening Lebanon's agrifood sector through strategic partnerships and innovation-driven initiatives.

**International Exhibitions:** In 2024, QOOT Cluster actively showcased Lebanon's agrifood sector at 4 major international exhibitions: ADIFE Abu Dhabi, SIAL Paris, AFIA Agri-food innovation Award, and HORECA Lebanon. Through these platforms, over 40 Lebanese SMEs gained visibility, engaged in 500+ B2B matchmaking sessions, and secured new market opportunities. QOOT played a pivotal role in organizing the Lebanese Pavilion, facilitating business connections, and promoting innovation, reinforcing Lebanon's presence on the global agrifood stage despite challenging circumstances. These efforts led to incremental sales exceeding 1 million USD, highlighting the impact of QOOT Cluster's initiatives on the agrifood sector's growth.

**Capacity Building:** In 2024, QOOT Cluster secured 250 hours of capacity building activities, equipping Lebanese agrifood SMEs with essential skills in innovation, market access, and business growth.
